

HEMISFERIO is an annual nonprofit journal that is linked to the Inter-American Defense College's academic program. The journal follows a multidisciplinary approach and aims to promote research on western hemispheric defense and security issues. The topical spectrum is broad and contributes to defense and security analysis from varying perspectives including Strategic Thinking, International Relations, Political Economy, Forecasting Research Methodology, Geopolitics, Human Rights, Civil-Military Relations, Multi-Dimensional Security, and Conflict Analysis and Resolution.

The journal's editorial policy requires that submissions be original unpublished papers that meet the highest academic ethical standards. Additionally, contributions must comply with the following editorial criterion:

1. Titles – mixed case (not all uppercase)
2. Abstract – less than 150 words, and must include up to 5 keywords
3. Paper size – Letter 8.5" x 11"
4. Article font – Times New Roman, 12 point, 1.5 interline spacing.
5. Endnotes (not footnotes) – Times New Roman, 10 point, single interline spacing, first line indent 0.25".
6. Citations (endnotes) bibliography – Chicago Manual of Style.
7. Language – English, Spanish, Portuguese, or French.
8. Submission length – not to exceed 25 pages.

Once proposals are received by email, authors will receive a message acknowledging the submission. Proposals that meet the above publishing and editorial criteria will be blind peer-reviewed by two reviewers, and authors will be notified of the final decision within 45 days.
